Civil Aviation Master Degree

Graduation credit requirements are at least 34 credits, which includes:

- 1. Minimum 24 credits of selective courses which include at least 3 core courses. The core courses must be passed with scores of 70 or above.
- 2. Seminars are compulsory at each semester. The seminars are 1 credit each semester from the 1st to the 4th semester, and 0 credits for 5th semester and above. If the application of the Master degree oral defense is to be filed in the first academic year (2nd semester), 2 credits of seminars must have been completed, the remaining 2 credits of seminars must be substituted by taking elective courses.
- 3. 6 credits for Master Thesis.
- 4. The core courses requirements for graduate students of the civil aviation institute are as follows:
 - (1) Q451100 Civil Aviation Practical Training
 - (2) Q470100 Aviation Safety Management
 Q460400 Civil Aviation System
 Q450700 Multivariate Analysis and Applications
 Choose 2 of the above 3 courses.
